

#### **TOWN HISTORY**

Eliot was settled in 1623 and the area was known as "Middle Parish" and "Garden of Kittery" in the Town of Kittery. On March 1, 1810, it separated and became the Town of Eliot. In historic Eliot, residents worked in maritime occupations, ran grist and saw mills, farmed the land, raised livestock, built ships, and labored at making bricks. As the town grew, it retained a village atmosphere on its river's edge and many of its farming areas in the east.

Modern Eliot has a Select Board/Town Manager form of government that was established through Town Charter in 2015. Eliot is a friendly, family oriented community in Southern York County with a population of about 6,700. It offers many services to its residents, yet maintains a charming small-town character. Safe neighborhoods, convenient shopping, exemplary schools, and recreational activities for all ages make Eliot a great place to live, work, and play.



#### MAINE MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION

Maine law requires a Maine motor vehicle registration be applied for within 30 days of residency being declared or established. Every owner and/or operator of a motor vehicle must also establish and maintain motor vehicle liability insurance and present evidence of such upon request by a law enforcement officer. All motor vehicles bearing a Maine registration must pass an annual inspection, performed at an official inspection station, before being operated on any public roadway. Inspection dates are not related to date of birth.

The Town office processes annual vehicle registrations. It accepts cash, check, and debit/credit cards (with an added 2.5% fee.) More information can be found at www.eliotmaine.org/town-clerk/pages/motor-vehicle-registrations, or by contacting the Town Clerk's office at 207-439-1817.




#### THE BICENTENNIAL OF MAINE

Eliot began its year-long celebration of the State's Bicentennial in August of 2019, with opening ceremonies and raising of the Maine Bicentennial Flag. In March of 2020, just as the committee was prepared for an old fashioned Community Bean Supper, Covid-19 hit. Plans across the community had to be set aside. In April of 2021, the State declared that the celebration would continue, to be re-christened *Maine's* "200-Plus-One" Bicentennial Celebration.

The **Eliot Celebrates Maine Bicentennial Committee** searched for new and creative ways to respond, while abiding by Maine CDC Covid-19 protocols. Events included self-guided historical sites tours and open houses at historical buildings. The bean supper morphed into an Old Home Day picnic in August 2021 with music, activities for the children, honors to Fabyan Drake Award recipients, even Maine whoopie pies. A time capsule was created, commemorating the 2020/2021 years and sealed on Eliot Festival Day, September 25, 2021, bringing to a close our celebration of Maine's Bicentennial!

There are three points to be stressed, finally, in connection with the tradition of funeral flowers. First, the role of flowers are both symbolic and aesthetic. They add great value to the richness and meaning of the ritual. Second, flowers represent sympathy extended to the bereaved. Third, flowers are sent to both the living and the dead. They are sent to the living as comfort and as tokens of respect for the deceased.
